Provide engineering services for the removal of two existing cast-iron, sectional steam boilers at the existing airport facility and relocating them to the airport security building.

Design services included cutting and capping of existing services to truncate services into new building. Proper phasing was critical to maintain full airport operations during the construction of the new Terminal and Concourse.

Other design components include steam, condensate, and gas piping, gas train, design of flue venting system, boiler controls, disassembling of boilers and reassembly to security building, including connecting to security building system.
