

**U.S. Olympic Hockey Training Facility**

Olympic hockey rink with locker rooms, training rooms and seating for 1500 spectators. The new facility will become the home practice facility for the U.S. Olympic Hockey Team. When not used for training, the facility is used for open recreational skating, figure skating and youth hockey. 40,000 s.f. building houses Olympic size rink, locker room, meeting rooms, administrative spaces, pressroom, public lobby and changing areas and support spaces.

Scope includes full planning, architectural, engineering and interior design and construction administration services. As facility is located adjacent to the Albany County Airport, site planning and structure marking and lighting subject to FAA regulations and specifications.

Mechanical scope included overlooking their work and review of the design of a design built team of Architects, Engineers, Developers, and Contractors. Electrical Scope included full lighting and power design.

Site administration involved supervising the Contractor's work to assure code compliance and Town approval throughout construction.
